

Description

The Years of Volunteer Service Pin recognizes an adult member registered with Girl Scouts of the U.S.A. for their active volunteer service at five-year intervals (5, 10, 15, etc.). This pin differs from the numeral guard in that it represents the number of years an adult volunteer has actively provided service, whereas the numeral guard recognizes years of membership.

The 5, 10, and 15 Years of Service pins can be purchased in the Girl Scout retail shop by the service unit or the volunteer; these pins are <u>not</u> purchased by the Council.

Criteria

- The nominee is an active, registered adult Girl Scout.
- The nominee has been an active adult volunteer for the number of years indicated by the requested pin.
