2. The Moses Myers House is located in historic downtown Norfolk. What period is used to describe the brick house? Name three architectural features used during this period.
3. What is the proper name for the lock on the front door?
4. What is the "passage below?"
5. Who painted the portraits of Moses and Eliza Myers in the drawing room? How might this room have been used?
6. What is a cornice and mantel? What are the cornices and mantel decorations made of?
7. Which room was added to the house after its construction in 1792?
8. Where is the kitchen located and why?
9. This house has four levels - three stories and a basement. How might the upper story have been used?
10. Name three musical instruments the Myers children learned to play.
