4. Visit Roanoke Island and at least two of the following:

6. Visit the Coast Guard Station at Oregon Inlet or Hatteras Inlet. Tours can be arranged by contacting the commanding officer. Oregon Inlet (252) 441-1685; Hatteras Inlet (252) 986-2175. www.uscg.mil
7. Visit Chicamacomico Life Saving Station on High way 12 in Rodanthe. Exhibits and beach apparatus drills are featured during the summer months. Call the Chicamacomico Historical Association at (252) 987-1552 for dates and time.
8. Visit the Native American Museum and Natural History Center in Frisco. Special group activities may be available. (252) 995-4440 www.nativeamericanmuseum.org
9. Visit Ocracoke Island — Take a self-guided tour by getting a map from the Chamber of Commerce. (252) 928-4531 www.ocracokeisland.com
10. Visit the beach. Do at least two of these activities:
 - Learn about tide changes. Is the tide getting higher or lower? How does the moon affect the tide?
 - Observe wave patterns. What causes waves? Learn about rip currents. How should you swim out of a rip current?
 - Look for animal life along the beach such as crabs, mollusks and other marine life. Identify some of the birds.
