This scholarship was created for Girl Scouts of the Colonial Coast to provide support to girls pursuing higher education opportunities to include vocational training and undergraduate education. This scholarship will provide more opportunities for girls looking to further their skills and education all while fueling the leadership and workforce pipeline.

The scholarship will be awarded in fall of 2021 with a minimum award amount of \$500. Scholarship is available to girls who are currently enrolled in high school or higher education/a training program.
