There will be a \$30 charge for each hammock or tarp that is damaged.																	
No charge for Girl Scout Council or United Way adult meetings and training events.																	
Nonprofit & outside groups must sign a Hold Harmless Agreement & provide the Council a Certificate of Comprehensive General Liability Insurance naming the Girl Scouts of Colonial Coast as co-insured.																	
Nonprofit groups must provide 501-C-3 documentation to receive nonprofit rates.
