REGISTRATION

When does registration open?

Registration for G.I.R.L. 2020 will open in January 2020.

Do registrants register through their Girl Scout council?

Only elected delegates must register through their Girl Scout council representative. All other registrants may go directly through the registration portal, which will be live on the G.I.R.L. 2020 website in January 2020.

HOUSING and TRANSPORTATION

How do I reserve hotel rooms?

GSUSA has contracted with hotels in Orlando, Florida and negotiated rates and services. By booking within the block of rooms reserved for Girl Scouts you help keep costs down for all participants. Hotel reservations may be made once registration opens in January 2020.

What are the hotel prices?

We have thousands of rooms (single - quad accommodations) reserved for our participants and the costs range from \$70-270 per night...no need to book earlier than January! By booking with the hotels GSUSA has reserved (also known as within the housing block) you'll have access to ground transportation, and other amenities that you won't have if you use other housing.
