COVID-19 TRAVEL GUIDELINES

Effective June 1, 2021

Travel and overnight stay. GSCCC will be permitting travel and overnight stays in limited capacities. As always, regardless of COVID-19 restrictions, volunteers must follow guidance in <u>Safety Activity Checkpoints</u>. Your trip requests should go through your service unit trip coordinator prior to coming to the council office for approval. Continue to practice the Hygiene and COVID-19 Risk Mitigation guidance outlined in the *Troop Guidelines*.

Additional Guidelines/Reminders for Overnight Trips/Travel

- 75% of girls in the troop must be participating in the trip.
- No international travel permitted at this time.
- Follow current trip approval process to submit trip requests.
- Trips and travel are approved on an individual basis. Approval must be granted by the Vice President of Member Engagement.
- Additional adult supervision may be needed.
- Travel coordinators must know and comply with all state safety guidelines for the state in which they are traveling.
- Girls must have their own bed if they are sharing a room with a non-family member.
- Girls may share a bed if all room occupants are from the same family.

Camping on Council Properties. Beginning June 1, 2021, troops can reserve camping sites on our properties.
