Summary: The Council Archery Instructor will instruct girls on using the archery range.

Term of Appointment: Three Years

Volunteer Responsibilities:

- Complete required coursework (USA Archery Instructor Course) as assigned and provided by Girl Scouts of the Colonial Coast and GSUSA.
- Remain informed about, and comply with, the most current policies, procedures and guidelines of Girl Scouts of the Colonial Coast and Girl Scouts of the USA (GSUSA) for Archery, including *Volunteer Essentials* and *Safety Activity Checkpoints*.
- Agreeable to have their name placed on a list that will be shared with other members of the Council in case they are seeking an outdoor adventure instructor for archery.
- Must be First Aid/CPR/AED certified or have another volunteer with them who is First Aid/CPR/AED certified (the event may provide the first-aider)

Qualifications/ Core Competencies:

- **Girl focus:** Empower girls to lead activities, learn by doing, and cooperate with others on current issues that involve their interests and needs, while having fun.
- **Personal integrity:** Demonstrate dependability, honesty, and credibility.
- **Adaptability:** Adjust, modify own behavior, and remain flexible and tolerant in response to changing situations and environments.
- **Oral communication:** Express ideas and facts clearly and accurately in person and on the phone.
- **Fostering diversity:** Understand, reflect and embrace differences.
- **Computer Skills:** Ability to use email and internet required.
- **Other requirements include:**
 - Must become a registered adult member of GSUSA.
 - Criminal background check on file with GSCCC.
 - Must be an approved volunteer.
 - Have current USA Archery Instructor Certification.
