

# Use of Council Properties (Outdoor)

*Updated September 4, 2020*

As some troops choose to hold in-person outdoor troop meetings, many may be seeking outdoor locations. Beginning Saturday, September 12, 2020, GSCCC will be allowing outdoor use of Council properties. Troops will be able to reserve outdoor sites at our various locations including **A Place for Girls (APFG)**, **Camp Apasus**, **Camp Burke's Mill Pond**, **Camp Darden**, and **Camp Skimino**. In order to maintain proper social distancing and capacity restrictions, reservations are required.

To reserve a property, the following applies:

- Review the requirements regarding outside troop meetings [here](#).
- Meetings cannot exceed 2 hours.
- Troops may schedule up to two meetings per reservation.
- Property capacity is limited to no more than 50 people at a time.
- Reservations can be made by contacting [customercare@gsgccc.org](mailto:customercare@gsgccc.org).
- Reservations must be made at least two weeks in advance of the meeting date.
- Social distancing and face masks are required by everyone.
- Troops will be required to clean up after each meeting. A cleaning checklist will be provided.
