This scholarship will provide more opportunities for girls looking to further their skills and education all while fueling the leadership and workforce pipeline.

The scholarship will be awarded for the fall of 2025 semester to the institution of higher education, with a minimum award amount of \$500. Scholarship is available to girls who are currently enrolled in high school or higher education/ training program.
