

Climbing Wall Course Instructor Record

In order to ensure the safety of our girls and adults, volunteers who have attended the Climbing Wall training to become a Climbing Wall instructor will actively provide at least eight hours of instruction during a 12-month period. Options for providing instruction may include service unit encampments, core camps, Council events, and Climbing Wall with your troop. The Climbing Wall training will be required if more than 12 months pass without providing the minimum eight hours of Climbing Wall instruction. An instructor has 12 months from the date of course completion to complete the eight hours of instruction. However, she/he is still required to submit this form by June 30.

Use this form to record your experiences on the GSCCC Climbing Walls. Submit a copy of this record annually by June 30 to remain on the approved instructor list.
