In order to ensure the safety of our girls and adults, volunteers who have attended the Challenge Course and Ropes Initiatives training to become a low ropes instructor will actively provide at least eight hours of instruction during a 12-month period. Options for providing instruction may include service unit encampments, core camps, Council events, and Challenge Course with your troop. The Challenge Course training will be required if more than 12 months pass without providing the minimum eight hours of Challenge Course instruction. An instructor has 12 months from the date of course completion to complete the eight hours of instruction. However, she/he is still required to submit this form by June 30.
