Patch Requirements

- 1. Adopt a public or private school.
- 2. Make a connection with the school principal and the school's PTA president or parent liaison and find out what you can do to help them, such as helping with a school carnival or holding a flag ceremony for a PTA meeting.
- 3. Host an information table during the school's open house/back-to-school night/meet & greet event.
- 4. Find out from the principal if you can do any of the following:
 - a. Post a "School adopted by ..." sign in front of the school.
 - b. Place a Girl Scout informational poster in the lobby.
 - c. Create a bulletin board somewhere in the school to promote Girl Scouts.
- 5. Complete a service project for the school and submit photos of the project to GSCCC at marcomm@gsccc.org.
- 6. Troops must email customercare@gsccc.org with the following information:
 - · SU#
 - Troop #
 - # of girls
 - · School interested in adopting.
