Great—each now counts as the prerequisite for the next! You can also complete **one** of the new Leadership Awards to build real-world skills and lead in the way that feels right for you. And if you've already started a Journey, keep going—you now only need to complete **one** (not two for the Gold Award!), and it will still count even after Journeys retire in October 2026.
