American Red Cross Adult & Pediatric First Aid/CPR/AED - March 15

This blended learning course equips you to recognize and care for a variety of first aid, breathing and cardiac emergencies for people of all ages. An online link will be sent to the participants prior to the course. The online portion (accessed via mobile, desktop or tablet) must be completed prior to attending the instructor-led skills session. Upon successful completion of the online course and in-person skills session a valid two-year digital certificate for Adult and Pediatric First Aid/CPR/AED is issued.

<u>Basic Troop Camping - March 22</u>

We will cover basic outdoor camping and gear, outdoor cooking and 'Leave No Trace.' The optional overnight will include night activities to do with your girls, additional fire skills and Girl Scout ceremonies/traditions.
