Girl Scout Week: Thankful Thursday



Girl Scout Week is celebrated each March, starting with Girl Scout Sunday and ending with Girl Scout Sabbath on a Saturday, and it always includes Girl Scouts' birthday, March 12. As part of our celebration, we're designating March 13 as "Thankful Thursday" and all Girl Scouts are encouraged to share something they are thankful for. This could be as part of a troop discussion, as an entry in a gratitude journal, or by sending a "thank you" card to someone special, like the one shown here!

Basic Troop Camping - March 22

Upon successful completion of the online course and in-person skills session a valid two-year digital certificate for Adult and Pediatric First Aid/CPR/AED is issued.
