

## **International Travel Permission for Minors**

Minors under the age of 18 traveling from the United States to any foreign country, when not accompanied on the trip by caregiver(s), are to have a notarized affidavit from the caregiver(s) not accompanying the minor stating that:

- 1. The minor is traveling out of the United States with the permission of the caregiver(s).
- 2. The non-traveling caregiver(s) is aware that the child is leaving on the departure date, and
- 3. The name(s) of the person(s) accompanying the minor.

Both caregivers are to sign this permission form, which is to be notarized. If the caregivers are not together, caregiver consent from both caregivers is still necessary. If one caregiver is the custodial caregiver or deceased, there must be legal proof/documentation of this status.
