- Sell to your neighbor.
- Sell to a former Girl Scout.
- Bling your booth.
- Learn about this year's mascot and share your findings with an adult.
- Wear your uniform when selling.
- Choose your recognitions.
- Practice making change.
- Write and practice your sales pitch.
- Exceed your sales goal.
- Use a cookie cart or wagon to deliver cookies.
- Reach out to your customers via email to sell cookies.
- Have one online Digital Cookie ship or online girl deliver order.
